— HOW TO USE THIS DOCUMENT

Every environmental form, *in one place.*

This document is a structured reference to the principal statutory forms an industrial or commercial employer in Haryana is required to file with the Haryana State Pollution Control Board (HSPCB), the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), or the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC).

For each form we have set out three things — the official designation, the purpose, and the frequency at which it must be filed. At the end of each section, we identify the authoritative source from which the latest prescribed version can be downloaded.

— SECTION 1

Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974

Governs the prevention and control of water pollution. Applies to any industry or local authority discharging trade effluent or sewage. Administered by HSPCB at the state level and CPCB at the central level.

— SECTION 2

Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981

Governs prevention and control of air pollution. Applies to any unit emitting air pollutants. In Haryana, every industrial unit located in an "air pollution control area" (effectively the entire state) must obtain consent under the Air Act in addition to the Water Act.

— SECTION 3

Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules

The umbrella enabling Act under which most modern environmental regulation is issued. The Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 prescribe standards for effluents, emissions, and reporting. The annual **Environment Statement (Form V)** is the most universally applicable filing under this framework.

— SECTION 4

Hazardous and Other Wastes Rules, 2016

Applies to every unit generating, storing, transporting, treating, or disposing of hazardous waste listed in Schedule I and II of the Rules. Authorisation from HSPCB is mandatory. The manifest system (Form 10) is the most-inspected aspect of this framework.

— SECTION 5

Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 (as amended)

Imposes Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) on producers, importers, and brand owners of plastic packaging. Registration on the CPCB EPR portal is mandatory, and annual recycling targets must be met through certificate purchase from registered recyclers.

— SECTION 6

E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2022

Imposes EPR on producers of electrical and electronic equipment listed in Schedule I. Registration and EPR targets are managed through the CPCB EPR Portal for e-waste.

— SECTION 7

Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022

Imposes EPR on producers of all types of batteries. Covers automotive, industrial, portable, and electric vehicle batteries. Registration through the CPCB EPR Portal.

— SECTION 8

Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016

Applies to every healthcare establishment generating bio-medical waste — hospitals, clinics, diagnostic centres, blood banks, veterinary institutions, etc. Authorisation from HSPCB is mandatory.

— SECTION 9

Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016

Applies to every construction or demolition activity generating waste above the threshold. Authorisation from the local Urban Local Body, with HSPCB oversight.

— SECTION 10

EIA Notification, 2006 — Environmental Clearance

Required for projects listed in the Schedule to the EIA Notification, 2006. Category A projects (larger / ecologically sensitive) go to MoEFCC; Category B projects go to SEIAA. Process: Screening (B2 vs B1) → Scoping (ToR for B1) → Public Consultation → Appraisal → Issue of Clearance with conditions.

— SECTION 11

Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991

Mandatory insurance for any unit handling hazardous substances above threshold quantities. Premium is computed by reference to paid-up capital. Certificate must remain in force throughout operations.
