— SECTION 1

Factories Act, 1948 — Safety and OSH Overlap

The Factories Act forms most relevant to industrial safety. (Labour-related Factories Act forms — Form 21, 22, 25, 11, 14 — are covered in the Labour Compliance Forms Library.)

— SECTION 2

Haryana Fire and Emergency Services Act, 2022

Repealed the Haryana Fire Service Act, 2009. Administered by the Department of Urban Local Bodies through the State Fire Service. Three-stage compliance: Fire Fighting Scheme approval pre-construction, Fire NOC post-construction, and Fire Safety Certificate for continued operation.

— SECTION 3

Indian Boilers Act, 1923 and Indian Boiler Regulations, 1950

Applies to every steam boiler exceeding 25 litres water capacity. Administered by the Chief Inspector of Boilers, Haryana (Faridabad). Registration of boilers, inspection of boilers, and certification of boiler operators are the three pillars.

— SECTION 4

Electricity — CEA Safety Regulations, 2010

Applies to all electrical installations. Administered by the Chief Electrical Inspector to Government of Haryana. Sanction of electrical load is granted by DHBVN/UHBVN; safety approval and periodic inspection is by the CEI.

— SECTION 5

Petroleum Act, 1934 and Explosives Act, 1884 (PESO)

Storage of petroleum products above threshold (depending on Class A, B, or C petroleum) and all handling of explosives require licences from PESO (Petroleum and Explosives Safety Organisation, Nagpur), with concurrence of the District Magistrate.

— SECTION 6

Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules, 1989

Issued under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Imposes specific obligations on Major Accident Hazard (MAH) installations — units handling hazardous chemicals above threshold quantities listed in Schedules 2 and 3 of the Rules.

— SECTION 11

Disaster Management Act, 2005

Applies to all industrial units, particularly those involving hazardous processes. Each unit is required to prepare a Disaster Management Plan and conduct periodic mock drills. The District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) is the principal interface.
